Wells Fargo recently donated a plot of land to Habitat for Humanity of Oshkosh.

Habitat Oshkosh plans to utilize this land for a construction of a home in this coming year. This home will be sold to a qualified family in need, at no profit to Habitat Oshkosh, with a no-interest affordable mortgage.

Wells Fargo plans to continue this partnership with Habitat for Humanity of Oshkosh throughout this year, and possibly longer. "We are excited about working with Wells Fargo to continue receiving housing plots from them," said Steve Hoopman, Executive Director of Habitat Oshkosh. "This partnership helps reincorporate vacant lots into Oshkosh community and allow the homeowners to reinvest in the Oshkosh economy".

Currently Habitat Oshkosh is looking to establish other partnerships, similar to the partnership with Wells Fargo, to aid in the integration of vacant lots back into the community.

In this upcoming year Habitat Oshkosh has already received partial funding for two homes and possibly a third. For Habitat land is the biggest part of their expenses, so the donation of land is a huge commitment to the Habitat mission of revitalizing Oshkosh communities.
